A Note from Pastor Ross

Saint Paul was one of the most educated people of his time. He was an expert in the Jewish law having studied in the classes of Gamaliel, one of the top teachers in Israel. But he said he would not brag about his academic accomplishments or his high position in the ruling class of the nation of Israel. Instead, Paul said he had only one thing to boast about in his life: the cross of Christ. Here's what he wrote: Galatians 6.14 "But God forbid that I

should **boast** except **in the cross** of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom **the** world has been crucified to me, and I to **the** world."

Why did Paul believe that the cross of Christ was the best thing in his life? Because it is only through the cross of Jesus that Paul or any of us have abundant life on earth and eternal life in Heaven. How can that be true? Because the cross is the power of God. 1 Corinthians 1:18:
"For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God."

The key to living the Christian life is dying to oneself. Want to be successful at work? Die to your desires, come alive to what your company or supervisor needs. Want a great marriage? Serve your spouse not yourself. Want to have a good friend? Be a good friend to someone else. As Jesus did, spend your life in serving, not in being served.

This month of April is when we remember the death of Jesus on the Cross and His resurrection three days later. He gave His life so that we could live. As we think about the gospel of Jesus this month, remember He did it for you as much as for anyone. You are blessed.
